

## TAYLOR'S TALK

This Monday evening, we welcome the players, officials and supporters of Shaftesbury FC to The Imagine Cruising Stadium for what promises to be a highly competitive contest, based on the evidence of the previous meeting between the two sides back on August Bank Holiday Monday! The visitors, under the guidance of Manager, Jim Milligan backed, allegedly, with one of the biggest playing budgets in the league moved back into the final playoff spot on Saturday evening after a comfortable 3-0 home win against Sporting Inkberrow, staying ahead of Bishops Cleeve on goal difference in the standings.



Shaftesbury ran out 3-1 winners when the two sides clashed on the Dorset hosts 3G pitch back in August, with the scoreline somewhat flattering the home side in a game that saw Marine match their opponents but failed to take their chances created. Shaftesbury's Jake Lovell was shown a straight red card first half for an off-the-ball elbow into Sam Turl's head, spotted by the referee's assistant, which was soon followed by another red card, this time to the home side's assistant manager for an off-the-pitch incident!

After Marine striker, Dan Warre, had levelled the score up 1-1 with a 25-yard goal of the season contender, the game swung back in Shaftesbury's favour after a Josh Blyth pass out was intercepted, the advancing striker was then alleged to have been brought down just inside the penalty area by Sam Turl, only for the Head Official to instead send Jamie Edge off AND award a penalty, disregarding the double jeopardy ruling!

Edge was then called back on, Turl was given his marching orders, Santos dispatched the penalty, the Marine supporters, not for the first time this season, were left befuddled and scrolling through FA Rules on their mobiles and Shaftesbury returned to their dressing room at half time back in the lead! Most bizarre! The second half saw Marine create the better openings before being caught on the break in the final few minutes.

To rub more salt into the wound, Sam Turl's red card was dismissed by the FA disciplinary department less than 48 hours later after the VEO video footage submitted by the Marine Management clearly showed Turl had made contact with the ball before the striker did his best Tom Daley impression!

Milligan's promotion-pushing squad is built upon a solid, experienced core of southern-based players with many having played at a higher level. Former Salisbury, Poole and Wimborne striker, currently top scorer, Toby Holmes leads the line having bagged a brace on Saturday, supported by ex-Wimborne Town team mates Harry Baker and Jack Lovell, whilst Alefe Santos adds knowledge and guile.

Friday night's painful 3-1 defeat here at the Imagine Cruising Stadium to a well drilled and clinical Larkhall Athletic side was slightly soothed by the improved attendance of 344 which ponders the question of whether we should try and go for another Friday night home fixture before the end of the season when neighbours, Swindon Town are also at home. With games running out, certainly an option to consider for next season!

# SHAFTESBURY 1888

## CLUB HISTORY

The original Shaftesbury FC were founded in 1888 after builders from Warwickshire requested a football match with the local men of Shaftesbury working on Motcombe House. This led to Shaftesbury Football Club being founded at the Ship Inn in the town.

Originally the club played at the original cricket field the other side of Coppice Street in the local Shaftesbury & District League.

By the 1930's the club began playing games in the wider area of Dorset and added 'Town' to the club's name. The club also moved to Barton Hill in 1935.

It is believed there was also once a ground at St James outside the town. An original history was written by former player Terry Warder on the 100th year centenary in 1988 and is a fascinating insight to the early years of the club.

Shaftesbury were founder members of the Dorset Combination League in 1957 and in 1974 moved to Cockrams with the ground situated next to the current one. Shaftesbury won the Dorset Combination League in 1988/89 and 1995/96.

A new ground was opened in 2001 with a 220 seat stand constructed. The club joined the Wessex League Division 2 in 2004/05.

## SHAFTESBURY FC 1888 - A NEW ERA

Relegated in 2010/11 back to the Dorset Premier League after some lean years as Shaftesbury FC and known as Shaftesbury Town as well the club became Shaftesbury FC 1888 and in 2015/16 were promoted back to the Wessex League as Dorset Premier League champions.

Now known as Shaftesbury FC 1888 FC taken over by the Coffen family after financial collapse of the old club and the name of the club incorporated the year of the original foundation of the football club in the town with Steve Coffen chairman.

Promotion to the Premier Division followed in 2016/17 and in 2021/22 the club won the Wessex League Cup and got to the 2nd Qualifying Round of the FA Cup playing Bath City from the National League South achieving a record attendance of 675.

The club now had a 3G surface installed and reached the 3rd round of the FA Vase in 2022/23 going out to Brixham AFC on penalties.

The 'Rockies ' were promoted in 2024 as playoff winners, winning the final 1-0 at AFC Stoneham to get promoted to the Pitching In Southern League Division 1 South for the first time ever.

Shaftesbury finished 17th last season adding a second consecutive Salisbury Hospital Cup win against Shrewton United.

Promoted back to the Wessex League as Dorset Premier champions.





## A VIEW FROM THE GS YUASA STAND

A very warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Shaftesbury this evening. The reverse fixture in August saw the Dorset side run out 3-1 winner in what was an incident-packed encounter. We know the challenge they bring, and the standards required to compete properly against them.



There is little value in being mealy-mouthed about Friday night. Marine's first-half performance against Larkhall Athletic was abjectly poor.

Larkhall competed, pressed with purpose, and worked tirelessly for one another. In contrast, Marine had to carry players whose body language spoke of hesitation rather than resolve. We did not collectively go toe-to-toe when the first half contest demanded it, nor did we produce the level of quality that teammates, management and supporters have every right to expect.

Losing can happen in football. However, you can lose with heads held high or you can supinely disengage from the battle at the expense of your team mates who are still battling. That disappointment with the first half performance was amplified by the occasion. The club secured a strong attendance with the "pay as you want" initiative proving a genuine success and drawing in a healthy crowd. The backing was there.

Marine supporters are, by nature, a stoic bunch. They understand the realities of football. They do not expect perfection. They will back the team in defeats where players have collectively given their all. However, what they do expect is commitment, effort and a visible willingness to fight for the shirt. On Friday many left disappointed by a shockingly poor first-half display. That assessment was shared by manager Bobby Wilkinson, who was forthright in his own reflections after the match.

Regardless of this evening's result the expectation remains clear. Every player who pulls on a Marine shirt must demonstrate the qualities this club has always valued: discipline, resilience, work rate and the courage to compete. Supporters can accept mistakes; they will rally in defeat when they see 100% effort given by all, but they will not accept a lack of application.

They respond to players who battle, who close down, who track back, who put bodies on the line and who show pride in representing this club. Effort is non-negotiable. The badge demands it. We know the Marine players are better than Friday's first half performance - now is the time to prove it.

## THE IMAGINE CRUISING STADIUM GROUND REGULATIONS

Swindon Supermarine Football Club reserves the right to prosecute, refuse access to the ground or eject any person who within the club premises is deemed to behave in any of the following ways. Please remember the following activities are illegal, dangerous, carry serious consequences and have no place in our game:

- Entering the field of play.
- Found to be carrying fireworks, flares, smoke canisters, pyro's, knives, and other article that might be used as a weapon and/or comprise public safety are not permitted in the ground.
- Being under the influence of alcohol or drugs within the stadium.
- Taunting opposing supporters.
- The playing of ball games during matchdays is forbidden other than in designated areas.
- The climbing of floodlights, stands or any other structure within the ground is forbidden.
- Using offensive, obscene, or vulgar language and /or gestures.
- Using terms of racial abuse and/or discriminatory behaviour.
- The throwing of any object within the grounds and/or on the pitch.
- Entering areas reserved for opposing supporters.
- Smoking in the ground is only permitted in the designated area.
- During matches glasses and bottles must not be taken outside of the clubhouse and alcohol must only be consumed from plastic containers outside of the clubhouse and at pitch side.

**The club may, at its discretion, bar any individual of such an offence for a period of up to 5 years. He/she has a right of appeal for reconsideration of the term after a period of 12 months has elapsed. Such an application must be made in writing to the club secretary whose decision will be final.**

**We ask that all supporters cooperate and observe the following:**

- Conduct themselves in an orderly fashion and refrain from anyone or combination of the following: Racism, violence, threatening or abusive behaviour and foul language.
- Vehicles are parked in the car park at the owners/drivers' risk. The club accepts no responsibility for damage to vehicles however caused.
- Emergency access route must always be kept clear. Any vehicle causing and obstruction will be removed.
- The club management reserves the right to refuse admission to the ground any person who refuses to comply with an instruction from a safety officer or steward or refuses to be searched by a servant of agent of the club or any police officer.

**Entry to the ground will constitute an unqualified acceptance of these rules and regulations and the rules of The Football Association and Southern Football League.**
